ORDINANCE NO. 2457

**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2184 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2454 REGULATING TRASH AND REFUSE COLLECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE, PERRY COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**Whereas**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 715.43, any municipal corporation may provide for the collection and disposition of garbage and refuse;

**Whereas**, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code § 715.43, the Village of Crooksville previously adopted Ordinance No. 2184, enacted July 3, 1995, regulating trash and refuse collection in the Village of Crooksville;

**Whereas**, the Village of Crooksville previously adopted Ordinance No. 2425, enacted December 19, 2011, amending Ordinance No. 2184, but amending said Ordinance only to the extent of increasing the permit application and renewal fee; and

**Whereas**, the Village of Crooksville adopted Ordinance No. 2454, enacted March 18, 2013, amending the above-referenced Ordinances only to the extent necessary to revise and institute a new allowable schedule for trash pick-up within the Village; and

**Whereas**, said Ordinance No. 2454 failed to distinguish between pick-up service for residential and commercial, and the Village Council now desires to repeal Ordinance No. 2454, enacted March 18, 2013, and enact in its place this Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2184 only to the extent necessary to revise and institute a the new allowable schedule for trash pick-up within the Village for residential service and to specify that trash pick-up for commercial service may be established as frequently as is commercially reasonable for the particular commercial entity served; and

**Whereas**, in order to alleviate the potential accumulation of commercial garbage within the Village, and the hazards that may necessarily follow therefrom, this measure should pass as an emergency in the interests of the general welfare of the Village of Crooksville.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 2454 is hereby REPEALED.

Section 2. **Allowable Pick-Up**. Paragraph 10. of Ordinance 2184 is hereby AMENDED and replaced with the following:

Days/Times of Collection; Holidays:

- a. Permit holders shall only pick up refuse, garbage and/or trash from or for its RESIDENTIAL customers within the corporate limits of the Village of Crooksville between the hours of 6:00am and 9:00pm, on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays. Should a scheduled collection fall upon a holiday, collection shall be made the following day.
- b. Permit holders may pick up refuse, garbage and/or trash from or for its COMMERCIAL customers within the corporate limits of the Village of Crooksville between the hours of 6:00am and 9:00pm, as frequently as is commercially reasonable for the particular commercial entity the permit holder serves. Should a scheduled collection fall upon a holiday, collection shall be made the following day.

Section 3. This amendment shall affect only the paragraph and section noted, and shall not affect any other portion of Ordinance No. 2184, or its previously amending ordinance, Ordinance No. 2425, as a whole.



This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in order to alleviate the potential accumulation of commercial garbage within the Village, and the hazards that may necessarily follow therefrom, in the interests of the general welfare of the Village of Crooksville, and shall therefore have immediate effect.
