

Crooksville Council Meeting Minutes

Monday, February 19, 2024

Due to Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Walters and Ms. Smith being absent, there was no regular meeting. Mayor Mohler, Mr. Loomis and Mr. Redfern were present. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present. A special Meeting will be scheduled for February 26th before the Workshop Meeting.

First up, Michael Salvadore with American Structure Point, was present to discuss what happened with the grant for the Appalachian Community Grant.. He went on with a lengthy explanation of what all led up to him making a mistake and telling the Village on the 6th of December they could still submit for the grant. There was still a step that hadn't been done that he forgot. This step was finding the correct entity for signing the sub recipient agreement. There was a two-step process that every community had to go through in order to get matched with a lead applicant and sign a non-binding MOU before the application was to be submitted. The MOU was never signed. Therefore, it wasn't submitted under Ross County.

Barb Harrison, from Buckeye Hills, was present to discuss more funds coming. Emma Yager and Brad Peoples, from Buckeye Hills, will be working with this community moving forward.

Jeff Dennis was present and wanted to know why he or the other businesses downtown were not notified and asked to join the other meetings that took place. Mrs. Tumblin and Michael Salvadore explained that they were phone/zoom calls. Mr. Salvadore explained that it wasn't really for the public, not that there was anything to hide, just detailed discussion on what the Village would need to do.


