June 10, 2024

Matthew from Flock was present via a Zoom call to discuss license plate reading cameras. He had mapped out two locations that he feels Crooksville would benefit from which are on 93 catching the northbound traffic and one on Ridge Ave capturing Eastbound traffic. He stated that they have been able to capture many suspects with these cameras and that we would be notified if a criminal comes into town if they are on a hot list and the license plate is caught on the cameras. These cameras are linked to other nationwide departments. They give notifications in real time to law enforcement officers. There was a lengthy discussion among the council. Matthew stated that he could send over a standard contract for the council to look over.

Next up, there was the huge water break on Friday and Mrs. Tumblin wanted to thank all the guys for all their hard work on that. They were there until almost 11:00PM. It was at the highway ridge over the Railroad trussell by the sportsman club.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin stated that they have changed the location of where they would like to put the pickleball court. They have rearranged the cornhole boards at Village Park and then they can get two courts for the pickleball there.
