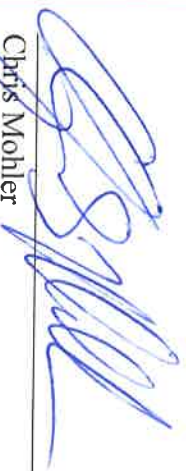
Mrs. Tumblin stated that the Christmas parade is next Tuesday, November 26th. The guys have worked extremely hard getting everything ready.
