RESOLUTION NO. 129-2024

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MORGAN COUNTY TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) TO YORK TOWNSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville has Emergency Medical Services (EMS) physically situated in close proximity to York Township, Morgan County, and is therefore able and desires to provide York Township with Emergency Medical Services (EMS); and

WHEREAS, York Township lacks sufficient Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and therefore Morgan County desires the Village of Crooksville to provide York Township with Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of York Township; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code under Section 735.053 allows for the Village of Crooksville to enter into an agreement to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville did previously enter into an agreement to provide EMS Services to York Township, which agreement was entered for a period of two (2) years and is now up for renewal, and the Village of Crooksville and Morgan County have agreed to enter into another such agreement for a period of two (2) years, at a mutually agreed adjusted price increase; and

WHEREAS, upon the foregoing, the Village Council desires the Village of Crooksville, acting through its Mayor, Village Administrator and Fire Chief, to enter into a new agreement with Morgan County to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.053 and as otherwise allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 735.053, the Village of Crooksville, acting through its Mayor, Village Administrator and Fire Chief, is hereby authorized and instructed to enter into a new agreement with Morgan County to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to York Township, upon the terms and conditions set forth in said agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is declared an emergency measure necessary for immediate effectiveness on its passage in order to allow for timely effect pursuant to commencement date called for under the agreement and in order to provide funds necessary to the fiscally responsible and efficient administration of the Village's EMS Department, all in the best interests and general welfare of the Village of Crooksville. This Resolution is therefore effective upon its passage.
