RESOLUTION NO. 26-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN ELECTRIC SUPPLY AGREEMENT WITH FREEPOINT ENERGY SOLUTIONS LLC FOR THE VILLAGE'S ELECTRIC FACILITIES ACCOUNTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Aspen Energy Corporation is an entity certified by the Ohio Public Utilities Commission to provide competitive retail electric Aggregate Power Broker Services within the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Aspen Energy Corporation presented the Village of Crooksville with an opportunity to secure its electric supply needs from Freepoint Energy Solutions, LLC, at a significant savings over that by which the Village has previously secured its electric supply needs; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville requires electric supply at each of its various facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Crooksville has determined it appropriate and in the best interests of fiscal responsibility and the general welfare of the Village to authorize the Village Administrator to enter into an Electric Supply Agreement for the Village's facilities for a two-year period commencing March _____, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Crooksville has deemed it necessary to pass this Resolution as an emergency measure so as to allow sufficient time to commence its electric supply savings at the earliest possible supply period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Lacey Tumblin, Village Administrator, is hereby authorized to enter into an Electric Supply Agreement for electric energy for each of the Village's facilities, for a two-year period commencing March _____, 2025, in accordance with the terms of that certain Electric Supply Agreement brokered by Aspen Energy Corporation, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.



This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall become effective upon passage, in order to allow sufficient time to commence significant electric supply savings for the Village's facilities at the earliest possible supply period, in the best interests and general welfare of the Village of Crooksville.
