

Village of Crooksville
Council Workshop Meeting
February 23, 2026

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith and Ms. McKinney. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Mrs. Tumblin stated they have started working down at the pool on the baby pool. Tim and Jamie have started at the pool house as well. Things look good.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin stated that the weed spraying they did last year saved a ton of money not having to have the guys out weed eating all the time. She spoke to Lance Sherrick who did it last year and he stated he would keep the same price as last year. Mr. Hampton would also like to make sure that they add Main, China, S State and Buckeye Streets curb spraying. She would like to put this on for next week to get approved.

Next up, Mrs. Tumblin stated that the Rec Center has been getting used a lot more and that the floor has been coming up in places. She passed out a quote from Mr. Foster for \$1,950.00 that she received to fix it. Mayor Mohler asked if Mr. Foster had insurance. Mrs. Tumblin states she will need to verify that with him. The council agreed to have it on the agenda for next week for approval.


Next, Mrs. Tumblin stated that Mr. Redfern had called her last week and asked if we had applied for the Snowstorm Relief money through the EMA. She hadn't received that email and believes everyone's email that was sent out through the EMA went to a junk folder. She stated with a little help they were able to apply and if it gets approved it will be a little over \$8000.

Up next, Chief Alexander was present to discuss Lexipool. He had already passed out paperwork regarding that. It would be \$3328 yearly. The council agreed to put it on the agenda for next week for approval. Mr. Hampton also asked about the Flock system again. Chief Alexander explained how it works and there was a brief discussion on that, and the council would like to revisit that.

Next up, John Mears was present to introduce himself and stated he was interested in joining the department. He stated he has been a firefighter/EMT for 2 years at the South Zanesville Fire Department. He is a basic EMT. They will put him on the agenda for next week.

Next, Chief Newlon stated they were awarded \$45,000 to buy new gear. He also stated that he had given them 2 papers with 5 ambulances and 2 companies with quotes. There was a lengthy discussion regarding each option. Option 1-Ford F-350 City Medic Ambulance. Option 2-Dodge Ram 3500 4x4 City Medic Ambulance. They are leaning towards the Ram. This will be voted on next week.

Without any farther discussion, the meeting is adjourned.
