

**Village of Crooksville**  
**Council Workshop Meeting**  
**September 22, 2025**

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern and Mr. Walters. Ms. Smith was absent. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, there was a brief discussion on the Buckeye Street Curve near Taylor St apartments. Mayor Mohler suggested that we paint the curb on the curve portion from the resident's driveway up around the curve about 15-20 feet to help the bottleneck of parking and not being able to see. Mr. Walters states there is no Ordinance that someone can't park in front of their own driveway. Mr. Loomis suggests a stop sign at the top and bottom of the street there. The council are going to continue to think of a solution, as they have not been able to reach one.

Next up, Mrs. Tumblin gave an update on the Employee Manual. She and Mrs. Edwards sent a new update of things that were supposed to be included and changes that were supposed to be made and were not. She stated that it is back in their hands now.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin states that the council has the Star Ohio handout from July and August. Reservoir #3 has been surveyed and had samples taken. They are looking at different funding opportunities. Mr. Redfern asked if there was any way we could manually drain it. There was no clear answer. He thought maybe we could save some money draining it ourselves.

Dyrall Newlon was present and stated that they had their hose testing and that they do not have enough. He states that they will need about 15 sections of the 2 ½-inch and for the 5-inch supply line they are down 300 ft. The tanker has none on it. They need about 800 ft for the tanker. He states that 216 should be done by the end of this week. (The price for the type 2 ambulance was \$88,000 back when it was priced before.)
