

**Village of Crooksville**  
**Council Workshop Meeting**  
**Monday, January 12, 2026**

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Ms. Smith and Ms. McKinney. Mr. Redfern was late. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Hailey Mallett was present to introduce herself. She would like to join the EMS department.

Next, Rhonda DeLa Rosa, was also present to introduce herself and would like to get into the fire class that starts Wednesday. She would eventually like to become an EMT. Mayor Mohler stated they would both be on the agenda for next Tuesday's meeting.

Next, Chief Newlon stated that he believes they need to get rid of B-215. He states that it is not safe to drive, and it has a list of things that are wrong with it. It had primarily been used at the racetrack before.

Chief Newlon also stated that the frame is not cracked on the engine. It is the support plate that is cracked. He states that it will be a lot cheaper to replace that part or clean it up and weld it.

Next up, Chief Alexander stated that they have found a magistrate. Mr. Wilson was not going to be able to do it. Steve Baldwin will be on the agenda for the next meeting.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin passed out an email from Grant Schooley regarding the B1/B6 update. They are looking at the end of March to be finished with the paving to be completed in late April, or early May.


