## **Council Workshop Meeting**

The quote is for \$4,489 as of right now for materials only. Its not ideal to start that right now and she is thinking spring.

Mrs. Tumblin passed out a spreadsheet of how much money has been coming in thanks to Trevor Miller with basketball open gym and Molly Lones with the climbing wall.

Mrs. Tumblin states that she would like to continue to be able to add trees at the park.

Next up, there was a brief discussion about the Beaumont being cleaned up for parking and it looks nice.

Mr. Redfern states that one thing he would like to say is that replacing old steel and galvanized lines that should have been done in 2019, needs done. From the old water plant coming towards town. Mrs. Tumblin states that there will be a lot of grants that will be needed because it will be an extremely expensive project.

Mr. Redfern states with The Neighborhood Improvement Program, sidewalk, catch basins and curbs need done in various places and to remove junk vehicles as well.

Next up, Mrs. Tumblin states that we are making progress on things and today we have electricity at the B1 Station.
