

Village of Crooksville
Council Workshop Meeting
Monday, December 8, 2025

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern and Ms. Smith. Mr. Walters was absent. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Mr. Redfern wanted to discuss briefly the Industrial Dr sidewalk, Phase II. Phase I is supposed to start in 2028. They discussed the route of the sidewalk and possibly a walking path instead of a sidewalk on a portion through South Park to Village Green. Mr. Redfern thinks they need to move forward and apply for phase II.

Up next, Mrs. Tumblin wanted to discuss the Solicitation Permit and how that works. She stated that recently we have had issues, where residents were being told that AEP was not going to be servicing the area and that they needed to switch carriers. Mrs. Tumblin wanted to see if there is anything we can do differently. A lot of people are not even getting a permit. One suggestion is putting it on Facebook to let residents know. Chief Alexander suggested maybe only daylight hours.

Next, Chief Dyrall Newlon stated that they need to send the EMS Charge Rate to Jan to look over. He also asked how many people they can send to EMT class. He states it is \$1655 a person. The council agreed if they are active to send them through for the classes.


Next, Mrs. Tumblin states that we need to come up with a pay scale for the Part-time Fire Chief and Asst Chief. Mr. Redfern suggested \$20,000-26,000 for Chief and \$10,000-15,000 for Asst. The council agreed on those range amounts.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin passed out papers that are a required course in March for RCAP Utility Training. Most of the council must complete it. Mr. Hampton, Ms. Smith, Mr. Redfern and Mr. Locke stated that Mrs. Tumblin could register them.

Mayor Mohler stated there have been a few people complaining about being able to make a payment, and he asked Mrs. Tumblin to go over that. She stated that this week only, we cannot take credit card payments, but all other forms of payments are still being accepted. We are currently transitioning to the new software.

Mayor Mohler stated Dean Wilson was willing to be the Magistrate for \$100 more than what Nancy Ridenhour was paid. The council all agreed they were fine with that.

Without any further discussion, the meeting is adjourned.
