ORDINANCE NO. 2749

**ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING, AND NAMINGCHANGING THE NAME OF
TUNNEL HILL ROAD TO OLD WATER WORKS ROAD
IN THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE, OHIO**

Whereas, on or about May 27, 1987, the Village of Crooksville did by Ordinance No. 2030, annex into the Village, that property which connected, included and brought into the Village limits such property occupied by Crooksville Exempted Village School District, K-8 School, High School, and Administrative Office (the entirety of such property, the "Annexed Property", and that portion of property owned and occupied by Crooksville Schools, "Crooksville Schools"); and

Whereas, the Annexed Property included a portion of road by and between State Route 93 on the South and State Route 93 on the North, along the Village of Crooksville Old Water Works Plant and the Crooksville Schools, known and named Tunnel Hill Road, ("Tunnel Hill Road"); and

Whereas, it came to the attention of the Village that it is necessary to name/change the name of and/or re-name Tunnel Hill Road in order to distinguish other portions of the same road located outside of Village Limits and within Perry County from that portion within Village Limits, for purposes of safety and emergency locating for police, fire and emergency medical services; and

Whereas, the Village Council for the Village of Crooksville now wants to approve, adopt, and name/change the name of/re-name Tunnel Hill Road within the Annexed Property as Old Water Works Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

Section One. Council for the Village of Crooksville hereby approves, adopts, and names/changes the name of/re-names Tunnel Hill Road within the Annexed Property as "Old Water Works Road," such road depicted as set forth in the document attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section Two. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and after the required number of readings and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the Village of Crooksville which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.

1st Reading: August 18, 2025 ;
2nd Reading: September 2, 2025 ;
3rd Reading: September 16, 2025 .

Passed: September 16, 2025 .


