RESOLUTION NO. 31-2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE BUCKEYE HILLS REGIONAL COUNCIL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT FOR THE VILLAGE'S OLD SCHOOL DRIVE BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Buckeye Hills Regional Council Surface Transportation Block Grant provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville is planning to make capital improvements to the Bridge on Old School Drive; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Buckeye Hills Regional Council Surface Transportation Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the Old School Drive Bridge Improvement Project will improve the public safety and welfare for residents and visitors of and to the Village of Crooksville, and encourage economic growth of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Lacey Tumblin, Village Administrator, is hereby authorized to submit an application for grant funding in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00) to the Buckeye Hills Regional Council Surface Transportation Block Grant program, for the improvement of the Old School Drive Bridge, in accordance with the plans on file with the Village Administrator.

SECTION 2. Lacey Tumblin, Village Administrator, is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining and/or accepting any financial assistance that may be offered or awarded in the event that the Grant is approved.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall become effective upon passage, in order to allow for timely preparation and submission of the application for funds, in the best interests and general welfare of the Village of Crooksville.
