ORDINANCE NO. 2610

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
THE STORM WATER UTILITY LOAN FUND**

**Whereas**, the Village of Crooksville, pursuant to the authority of Resolution No. 2017-65, did apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for a planning loan to complete a Storm Water Utility Feasibility Study, and was upon successful application, awarded such WPCLF Loan in the approximate amount of \$35,250.00;

**Whereas**, repayment of said Loan is not scheduled to commence until January 2020, and pursuant to said Resolution No. 2017-65, the dedicated source of repayment for the loan will be user fees charged for the storm water utility and/or the general fund; and

**Whereas**, until such time as a Storm Water Utility may be established for the Village of Crooksville, said Village is in need of a separate fund within its accounting practices and systems that will be utilized as a reserve fund for the specific purpose of accumulating monies and paying monies, as it becomes necessary, upon receipt of loan monies made available and awarded to the Village of Crooksville from the Ohio EPA, Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) sources and for expenditure therefrom for various loan-authorized purchases.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Village Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

**Section 1.** A separate and specific fund is hereby established within the accounting practices and systems of the Village of Crooksville that will be utilized as a reserve fund for the specific purpose of accumulating monies and paying monies, as it becomes necessary, upon receipt of loan monies made available and awarded to the Village of Crooksville from the Ohio EPA, Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) and for expenditure therefrom for various loan-authorized purchases. Said fund shall be known as the STORM WATER UTILITY LOAN FUND.

**Section 2.** Unless otherwise an emergency and approved in writing by the Mayor, the Village Administrator and Council, expenditures from said STORM WATER UTILITY LOAN FUND shall be made only upon authorization of Council, and for loan-authorized purchases only.

**Section 3.** Emergency Clause: This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Crooksville and the members thereof, and for the efficient and timely management of the loan funds awarded to the Village of Crooksville, as funds are scheduled for pay over to the Village


and must be timely deposited and accounted for, and expenditures from the fund must be paid out timely. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its passage.

**ORDINANCE NO. 2111**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 982 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE  
ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS**

**Whereas**, the Village of Crooksville, pursuant to its police powers, regulates parking within the Village of Crooksville; and

**Whereas**, on May 3, 1971, the Village of Crooksville passed Ordinance No. 982 Establishing Parking Regulations; and

**Whereas**, upon review of current operations and revenue, the Council of the Village of Crooksville has determined that an increase in the fine charged for parking violations within the Village of Crooksville is warranted and should be increased.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

**Section 1.** Section III, Penalty, of Ordinance No. 982 of the Ordinances of the Village of Crooksville is hereby AMENDED to the following extent and ONLY to the following extent: That the owner or driver of any vehicle parked in violation of Ordinance 982 shall pay a fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each said violation.

**Section 2.** This amending ordinance shall affect only the Section noted, and shall not affect any other portion of Ordinance No. 982 as a whole.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
