ORDINANCE NO. 2622

**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 2184, 2425, 2457 and 2522
REGULATING TRASH AND REFUSE COLLECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF
CROOKSVILLE,
PERRY COUNTY, OHIO,**

Whereas, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 715.43, any municipal corporation may provide for the collection and disposition of garbage and refuse;

Whereas, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code § 715.43, the Village of Crooksville previously adopted Ordinance No. 2184, enacted July 3, 1995, regulating trash and refuse collection in the Village of Crooksville;

Whereas, the Village of Crooksville previously adopted Ordinance No. 2425, enacted December 19, 2011, amending Ordinance No. 2184, but amending said Ordinance only to the extent of increasing the permit application and renewal fee; and

Whereas, the Village of Crooksville adopted Ordinance No. 2457, enacted April 15, 2013, amending the above-referenced Ordinances only to the extent necessary to revise and institute a new allowable schedule for residential and commercial trash pick-up within the Village; and

Whereas, the Village Council adopted Ordinance No. 2522, enacted April 20, 2015, to amend Ordinance Nos. 2184, 2425, and 2457 only to the extent necessary to revise and institute new and/or additional requirements for insurance coverage for persons, firms, companies or corporations that make application for and/or hold a permit for trash and refuse collection in the Village of Crooksville; and

Whereas, the Village Council now desires to amend Ordinance Nos. 2184m 2425, 2457 and 2522 only to the extent necessary to revise and clarify time requirements and implement late fees for haulers who fail to abide permit renewal deadlines and/or to timely provide required documentation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Paragraph 3 of Ordinance 2184 and Section 1. of Ordinance 2425 are hereby AMENDED and replaced with the following provisions:

The applicant shall, at the time of obtaining the application, deposit Two Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$200.00) for the calendar year in which the application for the permit is filed. The

permit shall be renewed on or before January 31 of each year upon a permit holder's application for renewal and the payment of Two Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$200.00) annual permit renewal fee AND the submission of ALL documentation required by the Ordinance, including but not limited to proof of requisite insurance, list of customers with addresses, and list of charges for services.

Any renewal permit applicant that fails to timely renew with the applicant's permit renewal fee and required documentation on or before January 31, shall CEASE and DESIST any and all collection services within the Village of Crooksville effective February 1 of the renewal year, and shall NOT operate or provide collection services within the Village of Crooksville until such time as its permit renewal fee is paid, its documentation supplied, a LATE FEE of One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00) is paid, and the applicant receives notice of permit renewal approval by Village Council.

A LATE FEE of One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00) shall be charged by the Village and paid by the renewal permit applicant for each calendar month after January 31 through the month of the renewal permit applicant's actual renewal of permit in accordance with this Ordinance.

Section 2. This amendment shall affect only the paragraph and section noted, and shall not affect any other portion of Ordinance No. 2184, or its previously amending ordinances, Ordinance No. 2425, 2457 and 2522, as a whole.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowable by law.
