**A RESOLUTION THAT THE CROOKSVILLE MAYOR'S COURT SHALL ACCEPT THE FILING OF A TRAFFIC CITATION OR CRIMINAL CITATION THAT IS PRODUCED BY COMPUTER OR OTHER ELECTRONIC MEANS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Crooksville holds a Mayor's Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Crooksville's Mayor's Court deals with traffic citations and criminal citations written by the Certified Officers of the Crooksville Police Department;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio:


1. That the Village of Crooksville's Mayor's Court shall accept the filing of traffic citations and criminal citations that are produced by computer or other electronic means providing said electronically produced traffic citations or criminal citations conform in all substantive respects to the Ohio Uniform Traffic Ticket. If an electronically produced traffic citation or criminal citations is issued at the scene of an alleged offense, the issuing officer shall provide the defendant with a paper copy of the electronically produced traffic citations.

2. That this Resolution is effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
