**ORDINANCE No. 2516**

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO CONTRIBUTE CERTAIN UNCLAIMED PROPERTY TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION**

**Whereas**, Ohio Revised Code § 737.32 provides for a Chief of Police to make donation of unclaimed property to a nonprofit organization if authorized to do so by the legislative authority, and if the property involved is not required to be disposed of pursuant to another section of the Revised Code; and

**Whereas**, the property set forth on attached “Exhibit A” is currently in the evidence room of the Village of Crooksville Police Department, has been unclaimed for a period exceeding ninety (90) days notwithstanding reasonable efforts to find the rightful owner; and

**Whereas**, on Motion to the Court of Common Pleas, Perry County, Ohio, Judge Tina Boyer authorized the Village of Crooksville Police Department to dispose of the property set forth on attached “Exhibit A” in a manner commensurate with whether the items are suitable for law enforcement purposes, suitable for sale, suitable for sporting or other appropriate use, or are unsuitable and should be destroyed; and

**Whereas**, the Chief of Police has recommended that the property on attached “Exhibit A” is unsuitable for sale as provided in Ohio Revised Code § 737.32, and/or that the costs of sale would outweigh the benefits of sale, and that a more appropriate and community-oriented disposition of the property would result from donation of said property to a nonprofit organization.

**NOW THEREFORE**, a majority of the members of the Council of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio, concurring therein, **BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED:**


**Section 1:** That the Village of Crooksville hereby finds that the property on attached “Exhibit A”: has been unclaimed for a period exceeding ninety (90) days notwithstanding reasonable efforts to locate the lawful owner; is unsuitable for sale as provided in Ohio Revised Code § 737.32, and/or that the costs of sale would outweigh the benefits of sale; and that a more appropriate and community-oriented disposition of the property would result from donation of said property to a nonprofit organization.

**Section 2:** That in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code § 737.32, the Council authorizes and directs the Chief of Police to make donation of the unclaimed property set forth on “Exhibit A” to a nonprofit organization, to wit: Crooksville Methodist Church.

**Section 4:** That this Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest date allowable by law.






Disposition of Evidence. :
