ORDINANCE NO. __2554____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2437 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE REGULATING MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL

Whereas, the Village of Crooksville maintains a Municipal Swimming Pool open to the general public; and

Whereas, on July 2, 2012, the Council of the Village of Crooksville adopted Ordinance 2437, an Ordinance Regulating Municipal Swimming Pool to revise and establish open dates, various fees, number of employees, rules and procedures relative to the operation of said Municipal Swimming Pool; and

Whereas, it is in the interest of the peace, health, safety, welfare and effective administration of the Village that said Ordinance is amended to the extent necessary to establish a discount for active duty military and their families as regards various fees charged relative to the operation of said Municipal Swimming Pool.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, State of Ohio, that:

- 1. Ordinance 2437 is hereby amended ONLY to the following extent: the following provision (e) is added to Section 3. **Fees**:
 - (e) Military Discount: Any and all fees charged under this section shall be discounted by 15% for an active duty member of the military and/or for a member of the active duty military member's immediate family. Documentation of active duty military status shall be provided in order to establish entitlement to the discount.
- 2. This amending ordinance shall affect only the section as noted, and shall not affect any other portion of Ordinance No. 2437 as a whole.
- 3. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
