NOW THEREFORE BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:




2. The amount above shown is hereby assessed on the property shown, and such assessment shall be certified for collection on the 2017 tax year duplicate in the same manner as general taxes.

Emergency Clause: This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Crooksville and the members thereof, and for the purpose of paying the expenses of conducting and managing the Village operations and reimbursing the Village funds from which the contractor was paid for the emergency demolition, and for the efficient and timely submission of assessments to the County Auditor for certification for collection on the earliest possible tax year duplicate. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect upon its passage.

ZBI mobilized to site (8) personnel, (1) CAT 314 Excavator, (1) CAT 228 Excavator, (1) CAT 246 Skid Steer, (2) Semi-Lowboy Transport & (5) Service Trucks to the job site. ZBI Project Manager Troy Jones arrived on site to coordinate the existing conditions with local authorities including Mayor Fred Redfern. Transport crews mobilized required equipment to project site. Upon clearance crews began demolition of building, utilizing water to control dust. All demolition debris was left on-site, filling in basement void. Once structure was razed, crews cleaned up around project site securing area as need. Once complete, crews de-mobilized from job site.
