Crooksville Council Meeting Minutes Monday, June 6, 2016

ROLL CALL: Mayor Redfern called the meeting to order with the following members present Mr. Locke, Ms. Driggs and Mr. Mohler. Tom Collins and Jan Baughman were present. Mr. Rice, Mr. Hampton, and Ms. Smith were absent.

Police Chief Rodney Walters was present to thank all of the Police Officers of Crooksville Police Department, Mayor and council for their support during the restoration of the 1969 Plymouth.
