AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF ANY TRASH OR
REFUSE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE AND ESTABLISHING
A PENALTY THEREFORE


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Crooksville,
Perry County, Ohio:

Section 1: No person shall set fire to or otherwise ignite
any trash, garbage, refuse, waste matter, leaves, grass, weeds,
wood, rubber, paper, cardboard, plastics, and/or any other
combustible materials for the purpose of burning or reducing it
to ash or to direct or cause any other person to do so.


Section 2: A violation of this ordinance shall be considered
a minor misdemeanor and whoever be convicted of or pleas guilty
to a violation of this ordinance shall be fined not more than
one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

Section 3: The final acceptance of this ordinance shall
repeal Ordinances Nos. 1047 and 1074.


Section 4: This ordinance shall be effective at the
