

ORDINANCE NO. 2202

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE CAMPING  
ON VILLAGE OWNED REAL ESTATE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council for the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio, that:

**Section One:** No person shall camp, park motor vehicles, or in any manner occupy village owned real estate without consent of the legislative authority.

**Section Two:** To use village owned real estate for any purpose, a permit must first be obtained from the village.

**Section Three:** No permit shall be issued to any person, firm or corporation for a period in excess of fourteen (14) days.

**Section Four:** No charge shall be made for the application and issuance of the use permit.

**Section Five:** The person, firm, or corporation granted the permit is responsible for cleaning and removing all trash from the permitted area at the expiration of the permit.

**Section Six:** The Village shall have the right to assess the person in whom's name the permit is issued a clean-up charge of up to fifty dollars (\$50.00) for cleaning and disposing of trash left on the camp site by the permit holder, or any other person occupying the site for which the license was issued.


**Section Seven:** This ordinance shall be read and acted on at three regular meetings of the Village Councils.
