**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-69**

*Adopting a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan*

**WHEREAS** the Perry County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) has developed a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan that includes all hazards to which Perry County and its municipalities are susceptible as per Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act;

**WHEREAS** the **Village of Crooksville** has been assessed for its susceptibility to all hazards;

**WHEREAS** a list of all critical facilities and other assets in the **Village of Crooksville** that could be affected by hazard events has been generated and included in a countywide list of assets;

**WHEREAS** the estimated potential losses that **Village of Crooksville** assets could incur during a hazard event have been calculated;

**WHEREAS** goals, objectives, and strategies to mitigate against the hazards that have been identified in the county, including the **Village of Crooksville**, have been developed;

**WHEREAS** mitigation measures for the **Village of Crooksville** and surrounding areas have been analyzed;

**WHEREAS** mitigation strategies for the **Village of Crooksville** and surrounding areas have been prioritized; and

**WHEREAS** Perry County's stakeholders and EMA have agreed to periodically review and update the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

**WHEREAS** this Resolution shall pass as an emergency measure in the interest of the inhabitants of the Village of Crooksville, in order to ensure that safety plans and actions are in place in the event of hazards that may occur in the Village of Crooksville and surrounding communities.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**


1. The Village Council of the **Village of Crooksville** hereby adopts and plans to implement the actions prescribed in the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.
2. This Resolution is declared an emergency measure necessary to immediately preserve the public peace, health, safety and property of the Village, and to ensure that safety plans and actions are in place in the event of hazards that may occur in the Village of Crooksville and surrounding communities. Therefore, this ordinance shall have immediate effect upon its passage.


