

Council Workshop Minutes Monday, March 11, 2019

Mayor Redfern called the meeting to order. Present were Chris Rice, Scott Locke, Bill Hampton, Billie Smith, Chris Mohler and John Loomis. Tom Collins was present. Brittany Ross was absent.

1. First on the agenda was Jenny LaRue from the Perry County Health Department. She asked if any of Council had the packet that she handed out the last time she was here and if not then she has extras to give. She explained the grant that was available titled Creating Healthy Communities. It has a 5 year cycle and tries to focus on policy, systems, and environmental change. She explained that she needs two new communities or a group of communities to work with and what projects this could work with including walking trails, policies to make areas tobacco free, or work with transit to work for a drop off and pick up location to be designated. They can work on projects with HAPCAP and can offer up money for match. Crooksville has the second largest population in the County and she explained that it would be great to be able to work with the Village. Tom asked if this money can be used as match with another project and she stated that they could do it that way. They are working on active transportation in the County and hope that they can get 93 to be a bike route. This was discussed in further detail. Projects would be started in 2020. The RFPs would have to be filed by July 30th so that is why she is out now to let different communities know this is available. Tom asked if there were any guidelines showing what projects qualify and she stated that she does and she will get that over to Mayor Redfern. Mayor Redfern asked how other communities planned out for 1 year, 3 years, and 5 years. Jenny stated that they have good ideas on what works for these smaller communities.
2. Council was given a copy of the Community Service report for week ending March 9th.
3. Council went into Executive Session per ORC 121.22 (G) (2) for Real Estate.

Council is out of executive session with no decisions made.
