**RESOLUTION No. 2016-76**

**RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT  
WITH THE VILLAGE OF ROSEVILLE, FOR POLICE PROTECTION THROUGH  
DECEMBER 31, 2016  
And Declaring an Emergency**

**Whereas**, the Village of Crooksville is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio and is duly organized and existing pursuant to the Constitution and the laws of the State of Ohio;

**Whereas**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 737.04, the governing body of the Village of Crooksville ("Council") is authorized to enter into contracts with one or more municipal corporations, upon any terms that are agreed upon, for services of police departments or for the interchange of services of police departments, in order to obtain police protection or additional police protection or to allow its officers to work in multijurisdictional task forces;

**Whereas**, pursuant to Ordinance Number 2558, passed April 18, 2016, and retroactively effective November 1, 2015, the Council determined that the execution of a Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Roseville for obtaining from Roseville additional police protection, providing for Roseville additional police protection, and to allow Crooksville's police officers to work in multijurisdictional task forces for the benefit of Roseville and/or Crooksville was appropriate and necessary to the functions and operations of the Village of Crooksville, and its Police Department, and so passed its Resolution and entered into said Agreement for a one (1) year period commencing November 1, 2015; and

**Whereas**, the Village Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Village of Crooksville to extend the operation of said Agreement through the end of this year, December 31, 2016, and thereafter to effectuate its annual renewal commensurate with the regular calendar year.

**NOW THEREFORE**, a majority of the members of the Village of Crooksville, Perry County, Ohio, concurring therein, **BE IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED:**

§ 1. The Village of Crooksville's Mutual Aid Agreement for Police Protection entered April 18, 2016, retroactively effective November 1, 2015, pursuant to Ordinance Number 2558, passed April 18, 2016, for a one (1) year period effective November 1, 2015, is hereby EXTENDED through December 31, 2016.

§2. This Resolution is declared an emergency for the reason that the above-referenced Mutual Aid Agreement may be extended through the end of the current calendar year and implemented at the earliest possible time in order to provide for convenient and necessary police protection to serve the general welfare and best interests of the inhabitants of the Village of

Crooksville and Roseville.
