

Council Workshop Minutes

Monday, October 14<sup>th</sup> 2019

Mayor Redfern called the meeting to order. Present were Chris Rice, Scott Locke, Bull Hampton, Billie Smith, Chris Mohler, and John Loomis. Tom Collins was also present.

First on the agenda was to discuss Tom meeting with Matt Headily in regards to County Rd 6. The area has dried up enough to track it now, as long as they can get the equipment in there.
