First on the agenda is information on the flood insurance renewal on Civil Development Garage #2, Sanitation Dept Garage, and the Rec Center.

Next on the agenda is the email from Kathy Maguschak in regards to the increase in the health insurance rate for the year. The increase was only a 2.9% increase which is down from 13% last year.

Tom will be meeting with DJH Computers on 10-29-19 to discuss them doing the majority of or computer IT work. George will still be working, but will be scaling back. The computer work is very time consuming, and George is needed in other areas.

Muni Regs would like to come back in to discuss vacant properties with the Council. The procedure to deal with vacant properties is a lengthy process. We plan on moving forward, to lessen the impact that the vacant properties have here in Crooksville.

A thank you is given to Rodney Walters who is working on the property maintenance problem in the Village. Properties are beginning to get the work done on them, and around them that has been needed.
