

Crooksville Council Meeting Minutes Monday, February 3rd, 2020

ROLL CALL: Mayor Mohler called the meeting to order. With the following members being present; Mr. Rice, Mr. Locke, Mr. Hampton, Ms. Smith, Mr. Allen, and Mr. Loomis. Tom Collins, Amy Utsch, and Jan Baughman were also present.

MINUTES: Motion to approve Clerk's Minutes was made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Mr. Hampton. Motion carried.

PAID BILLS: A motion to approve Resolution 2020-11 paid bills and payroll was made by Mr. Rice, and seconded by Ms. Smith. Motion Carried.

TO BE PAID BILLS: A motion to approve Resolution 2020-12 to be paid bills was made by Mr. Hampton and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion carried.

TRANSFER: A motion to approve Resolution 2020-13 transferring funds was made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion carried.

SERVICE: A motion is needed to approve Lacey Tumblin, Administrative Assistant, to be added to the Community Bank account as a 3rd check signer. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton, and seconded by Ms. Smith. Motion carried.

A motion is needed to approve pay increase for Lacey Tumblin to \$15.00 per hour while performing the Assistant Clerk's duties. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton, and seconded by Ms. Smith. Motion Carried.

A motion is needed to approve an additional Trash Hauling Service for Crooksville. Fees have been paid and insurance received by Waste Management. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton, and seconded by Mr. Loomis. Motion Carried.

SAFETY: The Villages of Crooksville, and Roseville wanted to take a moment to recognize three officers that were able to intervene and save a gentleman's life. There was an attempted suicide situation, and with their help the man was able to get the help that he needed. A big thanks goes out to Officer Holm, Officer Wintermute, and Sergeant Torres. The three of them were able to save a life, and they deserve to be recognized by both Villages.

BUILDING: A motion is needed to approve Ross-Frash Funeral Home's Building permit. There are no utilities at the build site and they would like to start ASAP due to immediate business needs. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton, and seconded by Mr. Rice. Motion Carried.

LEGISLATIVE: A motion is needed to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2671, an Ordinance to amend Ordinance 2455 of the Ordinances of the Village of Crooksville fixing and establishing water and sewer rates to waive 2020 water/sewage rate increase. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton, and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion Carried.

A motion is needed for the third reading of Resolution 2020-5. A Resolution authorizing the Village Fiscal Officer to request an advance of taxes collected by the Perry County Auditor. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton and seconded by Mr. Loomis. Motion Carried.

A motion is needed for the third reading of Resolution 2020-6. A Resolution authorizing agreement with GovDeals for the internet auction of Government surplus items. A motion is made by Mr. Rice, and seconded by Mr. Hampton. Motion carried.
