

**Crooksville Council Meeting Minutes Monday, February 17, 2020**

**ROLL CALL:** Mayor Mohler called the meeting to order. The following members were present Mr. Rice, Mr. Locke, Mr. Hampton, Ms. Smith, Mr. Allen, Mr. Loomis. Tom Collins, Jan Baughman, and Amy Utsch were also present.

**MINUTES:** Motion to approve Clerk's Minutes was made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Mr. Loomis. Motion carried.

**REPORTS:** Motion needed to Approve Mayor's Court Cash Book for December 2019. Motion is made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Ms. Smith. Motion Carried.  
Motion is needed to approve Mayor's Court Cash Book for January 2020. Motion is made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Ms. Smith. Motion Carried.  
A motion is needed to Approve Clerk's Monthly Statement for January 2020. Motion is made by Mr. Rice, and seconded my Mr. Locke. Motion Carried.

**CORRESPONDENCE AND MESSAGES:** Mayor Mohler gives a brief overview from the Thursday night meeting with HAPCAP. The work should begin around August or September of 2020. After the work begins, they will have 12 months to complete the projects, other than the punch items; and there will be an additional 60 days to complete those remaining items.

**PAID BILLS:** A motion to approve Resolution 2020-17 paid bills and payroll was made by Mr. Loomis and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion carried.

**TO BE PAID BILLS:** A motion to approve Resolution 2020-18 Bills to be paid bills was made by Mr. Loomis and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion carried.

**TRANSFER:** A motion to approve Resolution 2020-19 transferring funds was made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion carried.

**BUILDING:** A motion is needed to approve Bobbi Spofford's Sign Permit for the Pines Manufactured Homes Community. Utilities have been checks. The sign as already been placed. A motion is made by Mr. Rice and seconded by Mr. Hampton.  
A discussion is held on what the penalty should be for moving forward on the work before the permit has been issued. Jan makes a suggestion that an ordinance be put in place to institute a penalty if the work is done prior to the approval of the permit. No decision is made, but a future discussion and decision will need to take place regarding this matter.

**LEGISLATIVE:** A motion is needed to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance 2671, an Ordinance to amend Ordinance 2455 of the Ordinances of the Village of Crooksville Fixing and Establishing Water and Sewer Rates to waive 2020 water/sewage rate increase. A motion is made by Mr. Loomis, and seconded by Mr. Hampton.

With no further items to discuss, Mayor Mohler calls the meeting adjourned. Mr. Rice approves motion, and Mr. Loomis seconds this. Meeting adjourned.
