

**Crooksville Council Meeting Minutes Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

**ROLL CALL:** Mayor Mohler called the meeting to order with the following Council Members present; Mr. Rice, Mr. Locke, Mr. Hampton, Ms. Smith, Mr. Allen, and Mr. Loomis. Tom Collins, Jan Baughman, and Lacey Tumblin were also present.

**MINUTES:** Motion to approve Clerk's Minutes was made by Mr. Loomis and seconded by Mr. Hampton. Motion carried.

**REPORTS:** Motion to approve Clerk's reports for February was made by Mr. Hampton, and seconded by Mr. Locke. Motion carried.

**PAID BILLS:** A motion to approve Resolution 2020-23 paid bills and payroll was made by Mr. Locke and seconded by Mr. Hampton. Motion carried.

**TO BE PAID BILLS:** A motion to approve Resolution 2020-24 to be paid bills was made by Mr. Hampton and seconded by Mr. Loomis. Motion carried.

**TRANSFER:** A motion to approve Resolution 2020-25 transferring funds was made by Mr. Hampton and seconded by Mr. Loomis. Motion carried.

**PARK AND RECREATION:** The Park has been opened early due to the schools being let out due to the Coronavirus COVID-19. The idea of opening the park was to give something for the kids to do. This is not to allow teams to get together for practices. If this continues to happen the park will have to be shut down. There are not supposed to be gatherings of more than ten (10) people to help with social distancing to help lessen the spread of the virus.

**LEGISLATIVE:** A motion is needed to suspend the rules for 2020 Ohio Basic Code and Declaring as an Emergency. Motion is made by Mr. Hampton and seconded by Mr. Rice. Motion carried.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** A motion is needed to go into Executive Session per ORC 121.22(G)(1) Personnel. Motion is made by Mr. Allen and Seconded by Mr. Rice.

Out of Executive Session. Approval is needed to hire Marilyn Horner as the Village's new Fiscal Officer. Marilyn will start at \$18.00 per hour, and after her probationary of One Year her pay will increase to \$19.00 per hour. Motion is made by Mr. Rice, and Seconded by Ms. Smith. Motion carried.

**ADJOURNMENT:** A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Smith and seconded by Mr. Rice. Motion carried.
