Council Workshop

August 24th, 2020

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Rice, Mr. Locke, Ms. Smith, Mr. Hampton, Mr. Loomis, and Mr. Allen. Tom Collins was also present.

First up on the agenda is a discussion on the Groundbreaking for the new Fire/EMS Station. Details of the ground breaking will be decided by Mayor Mohler, Ralph Hill, and a few of the Council members. As soon as decisions are made, they will bring them before Council.

Geotechnical Consultant discussion is up next. This is in regards to the proposal for the field services on the new Fire/EMS facility. The cost of this will be \$30,750.00, this is on top of the already 2.2 million. This will be for inspections on the footers, and concrete. It will need to be paid for out of the Fire/EMS funds.

There was a discussion about what would be the best uses for the Cares Act money that the Village received. This money has to be used to purchase items that are to help with the COVID-19 pandemic. No decisions were made.

The Massey Ferguson 390T cab tractor with an Alamo 17' boom mower was purchased on GovDeals from Falls Township in the amount of \$15,000. Falls Township also has a 2000 Ford F-459, 6 speed, diesel dump truck that was previously listed on GovDeals for a reserve of \$10,000. It did not sell. Before they advertise it again, should me make an offer on the truck? Council feels that if it is something that we need to go ahead and make a reasonable offer for it.

The NRG had planned on replacing the partitions at the pool house. It is not currently ADA compliant, and if the partitions are replaced, the entire area will need to be upgraded to be ADA compliant. Without the lack of funding from the grant to take on that large of an undertaking, there was a discussion on other items that could possibly be purchased. Tom had the idea of a aqua climbing wall to add on to the pool. Once a decision is made, they will have to verify that this would be something that would qualify in place of the partitions.

With no further discussion, Mayor Mohler adjourns the meeting.
