First up on the agenda, Rebecca Snouffer addresses council with questions about the closing date for the pool this year. It is decided to have the last day on August 14th, and have doggy day the 15th. They will try to get sponsors like usual, such as a DJ.

There were no bids received on the Morgan County reservoir property. We will readvertise until another plan is made. Tom brought up the Neighborhood Revitalization Grant and will have more info soon. We got a \$25,000 match on it.

The Pottery Festival will be doing numerous kid's games on Saturday morning, the Chill-N-Grill has committed to 50 free ice cream cones. They would like the village to commit to 50 free swim passes. There are usually only 25-30 kids but are asking for 50 just to be safe. They will be able to use the pass for whatever day they want not just Saturday. Right now, there are 4 lifeguards scheduled to work Saturday.

Fall fest and Art Walk will be deleted from the Leckrone Sanitation agreement, and Community Days will be added. Tom emailed the attached names and positions for the dedication plaque out and everyone has agreed with it. The App Architect, location, and Robertson Construction will be added as well.



Rodney Walters gives a speech about his retirement. Thanking everyone for the years. He will be done Wednesday.


Council goes into Executive Session per ORC 121.22 (G) (1) Personnel employment, and ORC 121.22 (G) (3) Discussion on probable litigation.
