July 26th, 2021

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Rice, Mr. Locke, Ms. Smith, Mr. Hampton, Mr. Allen, and Mr. Loomis. Tom Collins was also present.

First up on the agenda is Dorothy Goebel. She would like to initiate the Hometown Heroes Program, which involves putting banners of veterans up on the utility poles around town. New Lexington and a few other towns have already done it. She spoke to Troy Nash at Sign works in New Lex, who did theirs. They're \$70 a piece not including the brackets and hardware to hang them. She would like to contact families to see if they would like to purchase one for their loved ones, deceased or alive. She will first ask Red Hat if they could do the banners instead to support a local business. Council suggests talking with the VFW and American Legion for help.

Next up, there was an estimate from McKee paving to pave the alley between High and Hull Streets. The alley needs a lot of prep work prior to paving. Ideally, new storm drains and catch basins would be the best solution.

It was decided at the last construction meeting to go with Crown Vetch on the banks in lieu of grass at the new fire station. It would be tough and time consuming trying to get a good catch of grass to take on a 3:1 slope, not to mention the maintenance involved in mowing and weed eating.

Tom would like to try and sell the Village Equinox on GovDeals and find another decent vehicle at State Surplus. Projects at the Rec Center are supposed to be done by August 30th.
