**SAFETY:** Chief Ralph Hill gives a final update on the number of runs for 2020. There were 1652 EMS runs, and 257 Fire runs; for a total of 1902 runs. They were up by 200 runs. The New AED machines are in. Village Employees will be trained on how to use them, as well as update their CPR. Several members of Council said they would also be interested in the CPR and AED training. Medicount is working hard to get everything billed. Ralph uploads the runs daily and they are billed out quickly. There is less wait time. Ralph, Marilyn and Lacey are able to look online at the stats, money billed, and received in real time. Ralph has been applying for grants for Small equipment. He is also submitting a volunteer grant, if they get it they will use it to get new radios.

Chief Rodney Walters discusses getting a grant from the Clay valley Foundation to get the Intoxilyzer 8000. This will enable them to be able to do inhouse breathalyzer tests. Rodney will have year end reports ready for Council as soon as possible.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Mr. Rice would like to discuss the Rec Center. Mr. Rice noticed several cars in the parking lot at the Rec Center, and Shane Dorsey was holding basketball practice. The decision was made that as long as Perry County remained in COVID Red that the Rec Center would remain closed. Mayor Mohler states that he will call and talk to Mr. Dorsey, and explain this to him.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion is needed to approve the hiring of Tim Linn, Linn Engineering, as the Village's Part-Time Engineer for the year 2021 for the sum of \$684.86 per month. A motion is made by Mr. Rice, and seconded by Mr. Allen.


