

Village of Crooksville
Council Meeting Workshop
March 13, 2023

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda is Nancy Tokie. She is wanting permission for a 5k Color Run Fundraiser for her 3-year-old granddaughter who was just diagnosed with Cystinosis. She is asking to do this event on August 26, 2023. Council members were ok with the event.

Next up, Pastor Joshua Stamper was present to discuss opening a coffee shop in town.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin gave council members the Southeastern Electric quote for the old football field at the Village Park to replace a rotted electric pole.

Mrs. Tumblin stated that we need to start advertising for pool staff. We will have to raise pay rates because minimum wage is up to \$10.10. Lifeguards will make \$10.10, assistant manager \$10.55, and the pool manager \$11.25. They were also looking at raising the admission cost, pool passes and pool parties as well. Mayor Mohler stated to raise admission cost to \$5.00 and to keep the 0-5-year-olds free and the 65-year-olds and up free as well. Council members agreed for \$150 for the pool party, bump pool passes up \$15 and admission \$4 for students and \$5 for adults.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin stated that Rick Dusenberry has decided to retire and will need to start looking for a replacement. Rick put a lot of hard work and pride into the park as a few council members stated.

Without any further discussion, the meeting is adjourned and goes into Executive Session.
