Council Workshop Meeting
January 23, 2023

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern and Mr. Walters. Ms. Smith was absent. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Ralph Hill introduced Jacob Ferguson, EMT/Firefighter. Mr. Ferguson put in an application for EMS.

Mr. Hill also discussed the Ohio House Bill 509, regarding continuing education and training. He then discussed the old 212 and getting it on Gov. Deals and using Covid money towards a new brush truck.

Next up, Mr. Redfern wanted to discuss the Historical District. There was a lengthy discussion on possibly meeting with the building owners if they are interested and if we need to move forward with filling out an application for the grant. The council members want to know what all the stipulations are for the Historical District and Mrs. Tumblin is going to get in touch with Preston and see what the next steps are to getting someone to talk to regarding all the guidelines.

Mr. Loomis spoke briefly about the Love Thy Neighbor Food Pantry and had a printout showing some numbers on what they do and how many people they supply for in the Village.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin discussed the \$10,000 Grant that Heidi Milner is helping with for the Water Dept. She also stated that she has been in touch with Estel about the 129 House Meters, 66 Pit meters and the smart points for both that are needed.
