**Council Workshop Meeting**

First up on the agenda, Craig Moore, from Hocking College was present to discuss the possibility of buying or making some type of deal to take some of the remaining equipment that is still at the old football field for their location in Athens. Bleachers, field goal posts, press box, etc.


Next, a very brief discussion regarding Edward Mitchell, who was not present at the meeting. He would like to have a fishing event at the pond this summer and would like to know if they could use the pond, if they would need a permit, and if they can stock the pond. Mrs. Tumblin stated she had thought he would be present but that we would get more information on the event.


