

Village of Crooksville
Council Workshop Meeting
February 27, 2023

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order, with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Kristi Smith with the softball program, was present to discuss trying to get the softball league started back up. She was asking, if possible, could the Village donate some silica sand. She stated that they would need 3-5 tons.

Mitch Altier, from IBI Group, was present to discuss extending the sewer near the ballfields out by the Crooksville High School.

Next up, Mrs. Tumblin stated that the papers were signed Saturday and the Reservoir Property is officially sold to Hunter Wheeler.

Mrs. Tumblin also stated that we need to find another person to clean the Administration building. Brandi Holsky had been doing it but is no longer able to. The Council agreed they were fine with that.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin spoke to Perry County Mobility Management. They will be at the workshop on March 27th to answer questions about the complete streets program.

Mrs. Tumblin spoke to AEP, and she will be meeting with him tomorrow to discuss replacing the lights they took down on the Industrial Dr. Bridge, the concession stand at South Park, and the Parks Electric.

The application for the Municipal Bridge Grant for the Buckeye St. bridge project will be submitted tomorrow.

Mrs. Tumblin brought up if anyone wanted to continue discussion from last week regarding raises for employees. There was a lengthy discussion asking if EMS was going to be added to the raise. Mayor Mohler also stated that Jan Baughman also needs to be added to the pay raise.

Next up, Mr. Redfern discussed the Historical District in great lengths.
