**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE VILLAGE OF CROOKSVILLE'S CREDIT CARD
POLICY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville utilizes credit card accounts for the purchase of goods and services for Village business purposes; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 717.31 requires that the Village of Crooksville adopt a written policy for the use of credit card accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Crooksville has set to writing a Credit Card Policy in compliance with the mandates of Ohio Revised Code Section 717.31, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Section 717.31 pursuant, and for the general welfare, public safety and health of the Village's residents, it is necessary to pass, adopt and implement this Policy as an emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CROOKSVILLE, COUNTY OF PERRY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

Section 1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 717.31, the Village of Crooksville Credit Card Policy, a copy of which is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein by reference, is adopted and implemented as Policy in the Village of Crooksville.




