SPECIAL MEETING:

First up on the agenda, a motion is needed for the approval of Resolution #87-2022, for the acceptance of the amounts & rates as determined by the Budget Commission & authorizing the necessary Tax Levies & certifying them to the County Auditor. Next up, a discussion of whether we want to put Reservoir 1 & 2 back up for sale. Council members agreed to do so at \$120,000.

Mayor Mohler discussed repair options regarding the Buckeye St bridge.

Council members agreed to put RITA on the agenda for next week's Council Meeting.

Mrs. Tumblin discussed that the Burr Oak bill was in, and we are down 1,954,499 gallons! The guys have done a fantastic job locating leaks.


Next up, Rick's mower is down. Council members agreed to buy a new mower rather than put almost \$9000 in repairing the old.
