

Village of Crooksville
Council Workshop Meeting
March 27, 2023

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order, with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Melissa Leckrone and Jenny LaRue from Complete Streets Project were present to discuss the purpose and policies of the program. They would like to start fixed bus routes in Crooksville, and throughout Perry County. They would like to bring 2 covered shelters to the Village, and they would loop to New Lexington.

Next, Jeff Dennis wanted to thank the council for filling out the applications for the Appalachian Grants. Kate was also available to discuss more of what was going on with some of the other funding opportunities that Buckeye Hills has going on.

Joshua Stamper was present to talk a little again about opening up a coffee shop here in town, and how he is behind the downtown projects that will hopefully be coming to Crooksville.

Next, Mrs. Tumblin talked about needing a new location for the salt. A possible location would be the fenced in area behind the gas pumps near the service building. There is not a quote yet on the storage. It would need to hold 175-200 tons of salt. She will be getting quotes and they are awaiting Oups to check the location for service lines.

Mr. Redfern wanted to discuss the Project Profiles for the Appalachian Regional Commissions and see what it entails and what would need to be filled out to submit if we didn't get funding for the Appalachian Community Grants, that we applied for. He asked that they pull up Buckeye Hills website and spend 15 minutes looking to see what projects they could put in for.
