Workshop Minutes

January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin was also present. Marilyn Horner was present via Zoom.

First up on the agenda, a representative from RITA is here to discuss their program. RITA stands for Regional Income Tax Agency. Their partnership is currently comprised of over 325 member municipalities and 35 JEDDs in 78 Ohio counties. RITA is a non-profit government agency created to administer income tax laws/ordinances as well as the tax collections and compliance concerns of the member municipalities. They cover about 50% of Ohio municipalities that have an income tax and are currently processing over \$1,500,000,000 in annual tax collections as of 2020. RITA is a full service and comprehensive tax collection and administration agency.

Next up there is a lengthy discussion on the timeline of the football field and getting the bleachers removed. Council would like to give the school till August 1<sup>st</sup> to have things removed and give the bank roughly 60 days after that.

Council talk about different ideas to do in Tom's memory. Lacey would like a plaque made to put in Council Chambers. The service/street employees wanted to name their new service garage/building the "TC" building after Tom Collins.
