Workshop Minutes

February 14th, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin was also present.

First up on the agenda, there is a discussion on what to do with Tom's Explorer. Rodney mentions giving it to Ralph to use for going to fire meetings/township meetings. We could put a Fire/EMS logo on it and use it for another vehicle to have on duty for fire runs, etc. Ralph said he could use it. The Chevy Equinox is in rough shape but Council decides to put in on GovDeals with a minimum bid of \$750.

Council has talked about selling the Beaumont building but it is currently full of stuff such as equipment, tractors, water project stuff, etc. There isn't another place to move everything to. The Reservoir Property will be up for bid again at \$145K, Lacey will talk to Jan about where we're allowed to post it at to hopefully reach more buyers.

There has been some confusion on what needs a building permit and what is portable or not. Mostly anything brought in or built on your property needs a permit. We have to have documentation of the permit and make sure they own the property it is going on. We also need to know that it is not sitting or interfering with any water/sewer (utility) lines.

The library has asked to use Reed's Park/Station for the summer reading program. The program runs from June 6th-July 11th. It would be each Monday from 2pm to 3pm. Council agrees.

There is a lengthy discussion on the documentation of septic tanks that are pumped every year. There is also one on solar panels for the Rec Center. Council discuss their feelings for it and some pros and cons. Most feel that it's not the best long-term investment right now.

Council goes into Executive Session per ORC 121.22 (G) (1) for Personnel.
