Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Mr. Redfern was absent. Lacey Tumblin was also present.

First up on the agenda, James Grimmatt bought his grandfather's property by reservoir 3. In the 90's Crooksville provided the material and the Grimmatt's put up the fence. He was hoping it would be the case now. After talking to Jan and Adam, the law changed in 2008 that required us to have to provide that assistance. Council thinks that it might be best to sell the property, therefore, they don't want to pay for the fencing.

There's a demo permit for 204 Logan Street, he is removing the old trailer that has been there and is wanting to start the demo ASAP. With council's go ahead he can start this week and it can be officially approved next week.

Alan Brown from Hull & Associates submitted a \$250,000 grant into Buckeye Hills on our behalf to go in with our sewer project on Main Street for next year.

If allowed, Bill Hampton would like to talk about giving employees a bonus for their hard work during the pandemic the last few years using the ARP money. He believes that the employees are our biggest asset.
