Workshop Minutes

May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Mr. Redfern was absent. Lacey Tumblin was also present.

Pat Moody with the Elks Lodge 509 would like to use the large shelter house on Tuesday, June 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm to celebrate Flag Day. They have several speakers and are wanting to display some flags for the community. The shelter house is not booked for that day so Council agrees to let him use it.

There is a quote from Southeastern Electric to replace an overhead electric line at the park that was damaged due to the ice storm. The Burr Oak water bill has dropped since last months bill. The difference from March's bill to April's was \$3,789.47 which was a difference of 806,270 gallons. Unfortunately, as of July 1<sup>st</sup> there will be a \$1.00 per 1000-gallon increase in the water rates. The new rate will be \$5.70 per 1,000 gallons.

L.A.F.F Camp through the Perry Behavioral Health Choices is wanting to use the small shelter house like they have in the past from July 25<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>.

Council decided to go with the commercial Zero Turn Mower for the guys instead of the residential one because it will last longer and be more effective.

The lifeguards will be on the agenda next week for approval. We currently have 9 applications all together.

Lacey will be meeting with Cy Duvall from Dant Clayton, they will be the ones removing the bleachers at the park.
