Workshop Minutes

May 23rd, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Mr. Locke was absent. Lacey Tumblin and Marilyn Horner were also present.

First on the agenda is Lisa Osborn to talk about our income taxes. She feels that going with RITA is not the best fit for the Village right now. Right now, we are able to deposit the money coming in every day, with RITA we would only be getting the money twice a month. She recommends waiting until we could afford it more. She gives some options on increasing our tax revenue that wouldn't cost us anything.

Next up, Marilyn is here to talk about the Fire Levy Debt payments. We currently do not have enough in the Fire Levy Fund to make the payments coming in July. We haven't received all of the township money yet. When money is put into our STAR OHIO account from certain funds it loses its identity because it's all pooled together as one.

Jodi Black in the water office has put in her 2 weeks' notice and will be leaving June 3rd. Marilyn Horner will also be leaving; she is retiring June 24th. Lacey recommends letting Courtney Edwards to keep training with Marilyn until she leaves and letting her become the Fiscal Officer after if she wants it.

We had applications from David Chapman, Kirsten Parker, and Madison Castro for lifeguards. The pool will be opening Monday May 30th. The pool staff will be getting together this week to start cleaning and getting things ready.
