Workshop Minutes

June 13th, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present; Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin was also present.

First up, we have some members of the community here to talk about downtown revitalization. Preston Frick from the Perry County Commissioners office talks about a plan for the Village. He would love to see the Village become a Historic District downtown. There's a Pipeline Initiative Grant that we can apply for, along with others. Community members express their concerns and ask about what is needed to make the Village have zoning. They want to make the Village a better place and be able to bring in new businesses.

The guys got the Disc Golf course up in the park, we've already had people coming down to play. We've had calls about people wanting to do swimming lessons. We are covered under our insurance to be able to do it. We could offer 5 1-hour sessions through the week for \$100. Council would also like to see the pool open until 7pm instead of 6pm for the rest of the summer.

After July 1st, fireworks are legal to set off unless council wants to change it for the Village. They agree to leave it as is, you'll still have people doing it regardless.

A student from the High School reached out to Lacey about wanting to possibly paint and fix up some things at the skate park for zero cost to us.

Wednesday, June 15th at 10:00am is the preaudit meeting. The Auditors arrived this morning to get started on the 2020-2021 Audit.

Kurt Torres put in his 2-week notice, so we will be hiring for another officer.


Council goes into Executive Session per ORC 121.22 (G) (1), Personnel & (G) (2), Real Estate.
