Council Workshop Meeting
July 11, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, representatives from the American Legion were here to discuss an issue when it rains, sewage is backing up into their toilets and overflowing onto to the floor creating a big mess. The representative had stated that they had spoken to Kenny Beisser and he had mentioned putting a check valve in. After a discussion Mr. Redfern stated they will have the check valve put in.

Next up, a lengthy discussion about rec center prices. Mrs. Tumblin stated there was a call of a woman who wanted to know about a price for renting the Rec Center all day. There were several numbers tossed out such as: keeping the 2 hours for \$100 and \$50 deposit. Possibly raising the price and deposit for 4 hours to \$200 and \$100 deposit and \$50 for each additional hour. No decision was made.

The Pottery Festival was starting Thursday in Roseville. No rides this year. The sale out at the school starts Friday and goes through Saturday.
