

**Village of Crooksville**  
**Council Workshop Meeting**  
**September 26, 2022**

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Mr. Loomis was absent. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Community members were present to discuss plans with the Appalachian Regional Grant Process House Bill 377. Jeff Dennis started off the meeting. He stated that Structure Point had come and walked through 16 buildings and there are 4 more on the list for Crooksville. They are putting together an estimate of what it would cost property owners and what kind of study they would need done to see what services they would need to go after.

There was also a discussion of more ideas on how to bring people to Crooksville. One suggestion was possibly more ball diamonds at the park with a nice concession stand.


A lengthy discussion on the kind of funds the businesses uptown would be looking towards. Jeff Dennis stated he would be looking more towards the historical funding to make sure the structure is sound on his buildings as to where Jamey Brannon is looking more towards the project funding to grow his business.


Next up, Council agreed on a time for Trick or Treat to be Sunday, October 30 from 5-6:30pm.

A brief discussion on Christmas lights and expanding each year with decorations at the park. Mr. Hampton brought up the possibility of having a Santa to pass out candy at the park like they used to at the old Fire Station.

Finally, Mrs. Edwards stated that Lori Hammer will oversee the Pottery Festival this year. She had stopped in to let us know that rides would be delivered July 9, 2023 and clean up would be July 16, 2023. She wanted to make sure Council knew the dates.
