Council Workshop Meeting  
October 24, 2022

Mayor Mohler calls the meeting to order with the following council members present: Mr. Hampton, Mr. Locke, Mr. Loomis, Mr. Redfern, Ms. Smith, and Mr. Walters. Lacey Tumblin and Courtney Edwards were also present.

First up on the agenda, Ben Carpenter was present to listen in on the workshop and to discuss any questions on House Bill 377 projects. The Ohio Department of Development has released deadlines and Mr. Carpenter stated that mid-December will be the deadline to apply. Kate, from Buckeye Hills, also stated that they will be hosting an in-person workshop in Perry County. Once the date and location are finalized, she will let us know.

Kate & Preston took time to discuss the Appalachian Community Grants Program. They are hoping to find out more about where the money can be used after the Webinar tomorrow. A lengthy discussion followed.

Next up, Ms. Tumblin stated she spoke to Kevin Smith and Mckee Paving will start working at the track around the old football field this Wednesday.


The Bridge Inspection Program will be put on next meeting agenda for an emergency.

The Reservoir Property will be in the Perry County Tribune starting this Wednesday and run for five consecutive weeks until November 23<sup>rd</sup>. Monday, November 28<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 we will begin accepting bids.

Next, Ms. Tumblin shared that after speaking with Dean Grimmitt, the Village employees are going to do a food drive for the food pantry. Mr. Hampton suggested we also put it out for the public to donate as well.

Mayor Mohler stated that the asbestos abatement should be finishing on the East School by Wednesday and then sent to EPA for certification. Once the certification has been signed off on, it will then be scheduled for demolition.
